

# Harrogate Music School Conditions of Instrument Hire

Over the past 30 years, the music school has bought a stock of instruments to allow low cost hire for students. Please help us maintain this stock by taking good care of the instrument whilst you are hiring.

- Make sure that you have notified your home contents insurance company of the instrument and its approximate value. Most companies will add cover for a low value musical instrument free of charge if it is detailed on the policy. Details on a recommended musical instrument insurance company available from Andy Kemp.
- All instruments are thoroughly cleaned before hire. We recommend you clean again upon hiring. Ask your instrumental teacher for specific cleaning advice.
- Harrogate Music School will ensure that all the hired instruments are in a good, playable condition at the start of the hire period. Instruments are expected to be returned in a similar condition.
- All breakages to the hired instrument/s (including strings), are to be repaired at the hirers expense. For woodwind and brass Instruments repairs, we recommend Dave Walker at All Brass & Woodwind, Leeds 01132-421332. For replacement strings & string repairs, please contact Sam Laverick.
- Do not attempt any instrument repairs yourself.
- Hire periods are for a month at a time unless otherwise stated.
- If an instrument is lost or stolen, the hirer is responsible for the full cost of a like for like replacement instrument.
